The word of God is effective and holy; it brings about exactly what it says. It is not futile or empty, but rich in meaning for those who hear and are healed. Those who hear the word of God and keep it will, with all creation, bear much fruit and sing for joy.”

FR. TOM'S MESSAGE

“Whoever has ears ought to hear.” Jesus gives the parable AND explains it for us. His order for us is to hear it. However, we don't go home today after Holy Mass content that we have *heard* the parable and its explanation. The question is where are we in giving good fruit? Growth is important! We know that Jesus has sown the seed on us – the good and fertile ground made good by the Holy Spirit.
