FR. TOM'S MESSAGE

"Many are invited, but few are chosen." We sing *come to the feast. We sing all are welcome here.* Words are words even if we sing them. Reflection on invitation reminds us who the King is and who is inviting us. The invitation comes from Jesus as He dies on the cross. We are chosen but we must *come to the banquet.*
