Today's first reading concerns the infidelity of God's people at Sinai. In the second reading, Paul's fervent wish for the congregation in Corinth, Greece. He mentions the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, God related to us and our salvation. In the gospel, God so loved the world (us) that he gave us his only Son. God, not far away, but closely present wants to be present to you.
